Show Rules

1. Entry fees - \$15 per class day of show. Entry fees will not be refunded after a class has started. Office must be notified of scratches 2 classes prior to the class. No refund will be issued if scratching within one class or at the gate.
2. On line pre-entry fee - \$12 per class. Pre-registrations must be received by 1pm on the day of the show to qualify for discount. Please go to www.fairfaxcounty.gov/parks/fryingpanpark/equest.htm to pre-register.
3. Keep and use the same back number for all the shows. Please remember to include your back number on your entry sheet. It is the rider's responsibility to keep and maintain the back number. Replacement numbers may be purchased for \$5 each. No number will be issued unless all fees have been paid or a signed check is left with entry form.
4. In the event of rain, a decision will be made by 1pm on the day of the show whether to have the show inside or out. If inclement weather occurs after the show has started then the show may be delayed or cancelled.
5. All entries must have a current negative Coggins test (within 12 months) before a number will be issued.
6. There will be six ribbons in all classes. Champion and Reserve ribbons awarded in each division.
7. The show will run in accordance with USEF rules as guidelines.
8. Frying Pan Farm Park, The Fairfax County Park Authority, Founders, Benefactors, Supervisors and Friends, their employees, and volunteers will not be responsible for any accident, injury or loss occur ring during the shows. Exhibitors enter the show under this condition.
9. Horses and ponies may cross enter where eligible.
10. Entries showing "unjudged" will be limited to the end of the class. Unjudged entries pay the same entry fee for each round.
11. At the option of management, a dotted line may be enforced.
12. A three-minute gate call will be given for all classes. If no rider enters the ring when the class is called during the three minutes, the class will be cancelled. Entry fees will still be assessed for the cancelled class.
13. Hard hats are required at all times while mounted. Juniors must wear safety helmets with approved (USEF or USPC) harness fastened.
14. All judge's decisions are final.
15. No collarless shirts or full chaps. Half chaps are permitted.
16. Frying Pan Farm Park reserves the right to change show rings without prior notice.
17. \$25 fee will be charged on returned checks.
18. All dogs must be on a leash.
19. The show will start at 4:00pm and will end NO LATER than midnight.
20. Schooling is open from 3:00pm - 3:45pm. No lunging in the warm up area or schooling ring. Call all jumping lines and be courteous to your fellow riders.

Summer Series Award Rules

1. Frying Pan Farm Park employees are not eligible for awards.
2. Riders age must be declared by checking the appropriate box on the entry form. This is the exhibitor's responsibility. Undeclared riders will not be eligible.
3. Juniors, adults and professionals are defined by USEF rules.
4. Scores based on 10-6-4-2-1-1/2. - Champion 10, Reserve 6.
5. Hunter Classic will be scored 10-6-4-2-1-1/2
6. Awards to be offered at the five shows are included below. No accumulation of scores between shows for the division award. Grand high point awards will be accumulated scores from all five shows.

High Point Awards

Frying Pan Farm Park will offer a GRAND HIGH POINT AWARD to the riders in each one of the following: High Point 12 & under, High Point 13 - 17, High Point 18 & over. Awarded to those who have the highest accumulated points throughout the entire five shows.

All points accumulated in Warm - up classes count towards High Point Awards

All points are awarded on same horse/rider combination

12 & under Grand High Point: Directors Chair

12 & under Reserve High Point: Hooded jacket

13 - 17 Grand High Point: Directors Chair

13 - 17 Reserve High Point: Hooded jacket

18 & over Grand High Point: Directors Chair

18 & over Reserve High Point: Hooded jacket

Division Awards

There will be end of series high point division awards in all divisions (Champion and Reserve). In order to qualify for end of series division awards, entries must show in three out of the five shows. Points are based on - 1st place 10pts, 2nd place 6pts, 3rd place 4pts, 4th place 2pts, 5th place 1pt and 6th place 1/2 pt - Champion 10pts, Reserve 6pts.

All points are awarded on same horse/rider combination

High Point Trainer Award

The High Point Trainer Award will go to the trainer whose students accumulate the most points throughout the 2014 Schooling Hunter Summer Series Horse Show. Points are based on Champions - 10 points, Reserve Champions - 6 points. Trainers, please make sure your information is complete on the entry form.

High Point Trainer Award: \$150

Open to riders 6 years old and under. Riders may not cross enter into any other division.

1. Lead Line (100% Pony)

Division open to riders 10 years old and under. May only cross enter into Short Stirrup Walk/Trot

6. Pre - Short Stirrup - Walk, Trot, Two Point

Short Stirrup Division

Open to riders 12 and under. To be judged 100% on Horse. May not jump higher than 2' at this show. Martingales permitted

8. Walk, Trot, Canter
9. Walk, Trot, Canter - 2 jumps at 18"

Pleasure Division will not start before 4:30pm

Pleasure Classes - Open to all. No Martingales

2' Warm up will not start before 5:00pm

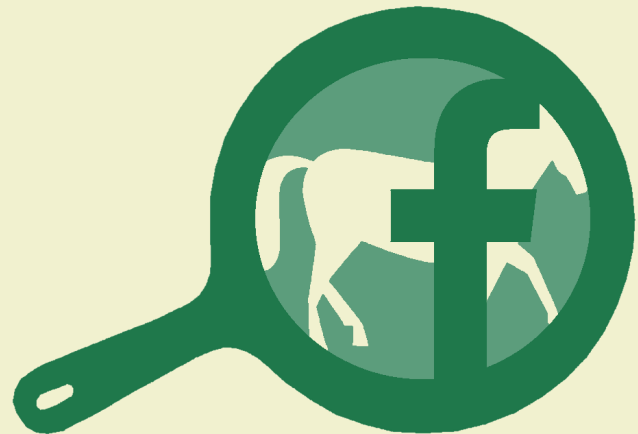
